

Field Intern – Summer 2018 Part-time (20 hours per week) Office Location: 2 Route 164, Patterson, New York 12563

The East of Hudson Watershed Corporation (EOHWC) is seeking qualified candidates for a part-time Field Intern. This is a summer 2018 internship - approximately 20 hours per week, for 8 weeks.

Background and Mission:

The mission of the EOHWC is to reduce phosphorus levels in the East of Hudson watershed by designing and constructing stormwater retrofits. The phosphorus reduction is a heightened requirement of the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System ("MS4") general permit. The East of Hudson Watershed Corporation (EOHWC) was formed in 2011 as a Regional Stormwater Entity to facilitate compliance with the phosphorus reduction requirement in the New York City East of Hudson watershed. The EOHWC identifies and manages the design and construction of stormwater retrofit projects in the East of Hudson watershed.

General Duties:

Under the direction and supervision of the Director of Engineering, the Intern will be responsible for performing field evaluations of existing stormwater retrofit projects throughout the New York City DEP watershed, which have been installed by and on the behalf of the EOHWC. Evaluations will include keeping a field log with project specific information and photos of each project site.

Qualifications:

- 1. Enrollment in related undergraduate program; interest in water quality/environmental issues.
- 2. The position will require some heavy lifting (manhole covers).
- 3. A clean driver's license and own means of transportation.
- 4. Excellent interpersonal/communication skills.
- 5. Strong organizational skills; attention to detail.
- 6. Experience with Microsoft Office including Outlook, Word, and Excel preferred.

Compensation: \$10.00/hour. Mileage reimbursement equivalent to the federal rate will be provided for work related travel.
