- Photograph, document and maintain operation and maintenance records for each inspected project
- Utilize and analyze project site plans for inspections
- Assist in investigations of new stormwater retrofit projects within the watershed
- Attend meetings with Executive Committee, stakeholders, and contractors
- Perform other duties as needed
